1. Elders Gathering

Edna started by summarizing the preliminary meeting with the Elders. The Elders would like to be more involved with RRC discussions. The Elders were introduced to the Community Based Fish and Wildlife Workplan and were given workbooks to take home to write down their thoughts in preparation for the Elders Gathering.

Kate, Colleen, and Mark added that it would be good to start the Elders Gathering with an introduction of the CTRRC and RRC projects. For the Elders, it is important to support and help each other, to support How We Walk, to discuss seasonal awareness for wildlife, involvement with the youth, and the future of CTFN and CTRRC data sharing.

Kate suggested it would be a good time to introduce the local knowledge survey to Elders.

The logistics of the Elders Gathering were discussed:

- 5. Moose Population studies (aerial surveys), local knowledge survey (RRC survey), and future gathering
- 6. CTRRC role moving forward, involvement with Elders, future legislation

Mark and Colleen agreed to review the potential agenda topics and derive engaging questions.
